Absence from school


School is open for children on 190 days each year.

The LEA target for attendance is at least 95%.

Children should not be taken on holiday during term time. If you are requesting time off for your child, you must ask for and obtain the head teacher's written permission. There is a form to fill in which you can get from the school office.

This is very important.

If your child is absent too often, you may be visited by the Educational Welfare Officer and possibly fined £60 for each parent.

Before and after school

We are able to offer limited spaces in our before school clubs. Please inquire if interested.

We offer various clubs after school for children in KSI and KS2.

If your child wishes to take part in a club, you will receive a letter each term which needs to be returned to school promptly as spaces are limited.

We do try to ensure fairness, so if a space isn't allocated first time, we do try to make sure your child gets a space later in the year.



School times

The school doors open at 8.30 a.m.

There will be a morning task for children to work on in the classroom and toast will be provided to children who want it.

The doors close at <u>8.45 a.m.</u> when our learning starts so please do not be late.

Lunchtime is from 12:00 - 1:00pm

School finishes at 3 p.m.

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We ask that you are on time to pick up your child please.

Children in KSI must be collected by someone over the age of 16. Children in KS2 are able to go home alone, if that is what you wish.
