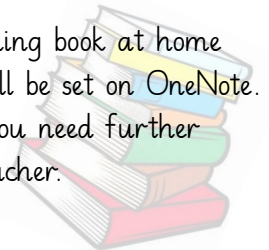

## History

During this term the children will learn about a historical event. They will learn to look at historical sources of information and compare the past to now. They will also learn about The Great Fire of London and how it started.



## English

### Reading

- Shared and guided reading will focus on key reading skills.

### Writing

- Children will be continuing to develop their writing skills by using conjunctions to join their ideas. They will be reading texts about The Great Fire of London and writing diaries.

### Phonics

- Children will make a start on the alternative spelling patterns and pronunciations in Phase 5 phonics.

# The Great Fire of London

## PSHE

For our second PSHE topic we will be looking at Celebrating Difference. Children will learn they are all unique.



## Music

This half term children will be learning about Voice and Singing.

In Maths, we will be focussing on:

- Adding and subtracting one digit and two digit numbers using a range of methods.
- Use practical resources to understand and explain multiplication and division.
- To start to explore word problems and develop reasoning skills.

## RE

This half term children will continue to look at Judaism and Christianity.



## DT

For our topic this term children will be learning about where food comes from. The children will taste and design their own bread. So look out for some tasty treats!



## Science

This term our science will be all about materials. Children will learn to identify and compare how suitable different everyday materials are. They will look at the properties of materials to try and explain what makes them useful. They will also explore how the shapes of materials can be changed by bending, squashing and stretching them.
