Some costing almost, if not double, what they were.

We understand, with the cost of living crisis, the impact this may have on you which is why we pay a subsidy to all our trips. This is so you never pay the full amount and why we ask for a contribution.

Last year, for all trips, families made a total contribution of **£4850** towards trips. As a school, we added a total of **£11 195.** The cost of trips will increase this year but so will the amount we put in as a school.

We hope you all continue to contribute. Without it, trips will not be able to go ahead and the children will miss out on valuable experiences.
